Summer Creativity Classes at the Elliott Museum are much more than summer camps. We provide young artists and photographers ages 7-14 a working studio, quality materials, and professional guidance from working career artists and art instructors. Summer Creativity Classes offer a variety of age-specific projects, skills and materials. **Note:** Member Discount applies to Family Membership level and up. ### Overview of our Summer Creativity Classes:

<u>Art & Craft Camp</u> offers a variety of creative projects including drawing, painting, pastel, collage, papier mâché, ceramics, and other fine crafts with professional artist and instructor, Melissa Nelson.

<u>Ceramics Camp</u> – Young artists will adore working with professional ceramist, Mia Lindberg, in these very well-rounded and creative sessions geared toward their age groups.

<u>Drawing & Painting Camp</u> - Artists will enjoy a week of drawing & painting projects in various media with professional artist and art instructor, Jennifer Foglia.

<u>Digital Photography Camp</u> - Livia will be back this year teaching her very popular Digital Photography Class. Class will meet on Wednesday at the House of Refuge!

<u>Painting the Masters Camp</u> – Professional artist and instructor, Danuta Rothschild, combines art history with learning how to paint the Masters in a variety of media, including acrylic, pastel, charcoal, and using mixed media to create texture.

<u>Creativity Camp</u> – New this year! Taught by two instructors, participants will be challenged to create abstract and representational artworks using non-traditional and found materials. Focus will be on composition, balance, whimsy, art history, and thinking outside the canvas.

All materials and a snack are included in our Summer Creativity Classes. Participants in the Digital Photography class must have their own digital cameras (no phone or pad cameras). Projects are kept under-wraps during the week to be unveiled each Friday thirty minutes before class ends, at a Museum Reception for our artists, their families and friends, including light refreshments. *Classes fill quickly - don't get left out!* 

<u>Please Note:</u> Summer Creativity Class sizes are limited, depending on the age group, instructor, and complexity of the class. We generally run with the instructor, the Art Studio Coordinator (who is also a professional artist), teen volunteers, and volunteer artists. Registration and payment will hold your space. No refunds, prorated fees, or make-ups are offered for missed classes, or for early withdrawal once the class has started. Classes are held only if the necessary minimum numbers of participants are registered and paid (it is rare that we cancel a class). Refunds for withdrawals prior to the start date are only made if we can fill the space from the Wait List once the class is committed to go. Once minimum enrollment is met, registrations will be accepted up to the day before the class, space permitting. Class may be canceled due to low registration no later than a week before the class. Full refunds will be given if we need to cancel a class. Class maximum: 12; minimums are generally 8 participants.

<u>Age Specifications:</u> Projects in the classes are designed for the posted age groups. We try to restrict participation to that age group. If your artist will be the minimum age of 7 years old within four months of the class and can keep up with older participants, we may make an exception. We will not accept children under the age of 6 years, 8 months under any circumstances. Projects are designed for the focus, skill-level, and discipline of ages 7 and up. We are not a day-care facility - no early drop-offs, late pick-ups, or after-care available.

<u>Discounts:</u> Museum Members at the Family Level may sign up at the lower price. The child must qualify as a Member. 10% Sibling discount applies for families registering two or more children in the same class and is applicable to Members and non-members and is in addition to the Member Discount.

<u>Cell Phones:</u> We ask that cell phones be turned off during class unless we hear directly from the parents that they need to stay on. Cell phones are disruptive to the entire class, a distraction for the student, and are exposed to many materials in The Studio that could cause permanent damage to phones.

<u>Snacks:</u> Snacks consist of pretzels, animal cookies, fruit such as grapes or watermelon, Rice Krispies Treats, Goldfish, fruit gummies, etc. We try to have something that everyone can eat but we cannot accommodate restricted diets. If your child has food issues, please let us know and send him or her with a safe snack.
